

## ECTS Grading System at Mendel University

### ECTS grading scale:

A	EXCELLENT – outstanding performance with only minor errors
B	VERY GOOD – above the average standard but with some errors
C	GOOD – generally sound work with a number of notable errors
D	SATISFACTORY – fair but with significant shortcomings
E	SUFFICIENT – performance meets the minimum criteria
F	FAIL – some more work required before the credit can be awarded/considerable further work is required

Grade designation	Grade	Recommended equivalent grade

Requirements not fulfilled	N	Fail or F

### Description of the institutional grading system:

There is a six-scale grading system:

- Excellent
- Very good
- Good
- Satisfactory
- Fail

### ECTS credits:

1 full academic year = 60 credits

1 semestr = 30 credits

All study programmes at Mendel University are measured in terms of ECTS credits. All courses have a number of credits allocated reflecting students workload that an average student will need to achieve expected learning outcomes.

One credit stands for 28 hours of total study time. Standard academic year is based on 60 ECTS, which is 1680 hours of student workload. Individual student can differ from this standard according to their capacities, skills, foreknowledge, and efforts.
